



Themes on security for SaMD/ SiMD

- 1. The relationship between safety and security
- 2. The relationship between 'injury' and loss of personal data and breach of confidentiality
- 3. Shared nature of the responsibilities
- 4. Scale
 - 223 NHS Trusts across the NHS Estate
 - ~ > 3,000 "connected medical devices" within each Trust alone
- 5. Legacy devices
- 6. Sometimes insecure estates
- 7. Increasing quantity of direct to consumer SaMD
- 8. Complexity in ensuring vulnerabilities are reported
- 9. Further challenges that AI can pose
